

## Certificate of compliance with the German Recommendation BfR XIV for HM100

Over the last years, the basic legislation that has been leading at the European level for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food has been regulated by diverse Directives and Norms. These Regulations have made provision for the adoption of specific directives or measures relating to particular groups of materials or articles.

In case of the acrylic hot melt HM100, used to manufacture the Adestor self-adhesive materials which contain a Supertack adhesive layer, has obtained the ISEGA certificate.

We herewith would like to confirm that the HM100 adhesive is suitable for use in direct contact with dry, moist, and fatty foodstuff with a reduction factor of at least 5. That is, all the labels containing the HM100 adhesive can be in direct contact with dry, moist and/or fatty foodstuff with a reduction factor equal or greater than 5, as indicated in Regulation (EU) No. 10/2011.

Also, the HM100 adhesive is in compliance with the American standard FDA 175.105, so that it can be used with dry foodstuff, either by direct contact or separated by a functional barrier.

This adhesive is also in compliance with the German Recommendation BfR XIV (Bundesinstitut für Risikobewertung) regarding the constituents subject to its field of application.
