

Certificate of conformity regarding Sensory Analysis for Adestor Art self-adhesive facestocks (Standard EN 1230)

Over the last years, the basic legislation that has been leading at the European level for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food is Regulation 1935/2004/EC.

The principle underlying this Regulation is that any material or article intended to come into contact directly or indirectly with food must be sufficiently inert to preclude substances from being transferred to food in quantities large enough to endanger human health or to bring about an unacceptable change in the composition of the food or a deterioration in its organoleptic properties.

For these reasons, and in order to assess whether the material brings changes or not in smell and taste of foods to which it is in contact, both properties are measured according to EN 1230.

Thus, as per the information available on tests done in independent testing laboratories, our Adestor Art facestocks in all its substances (80 and 225 gsm) comply with the Standard EN 1230.
