

Directive 2015/863/EC/ RoHS

Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment

The Directive (EU) 2011/65 (RoHS2), and Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015 (RoHS3), (amending Annex II to Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS2) of the European Parliament and of the Council) regards a list of restricted substances:

Based on the composition of our product (facestocks, adhesives and liners) and processes, and according to information provided by the raw material suppliers of the chemical products, we can confirm that we do not intentionally add any kind of above listed substances.

The exception corresponds to PVC films, and PVdC-coated films, which do contain such plasticizers (phthalates). Products are clearly identified into the product name and its technical data sheets.
